Councilor Baley made a motion to approve the Oregon Department of Transportation Safe Routes to School Water Relocation Service Agreement. Councilor Gatliff 2nd the motion. The motion passed 4-0 in favor.

City Recorder Hernandez described the CIS public Safety Grant that includes Body Cameras. Police Commissioner McCollam was in favor of submitting the grant.


ADJOURN MEETING:


