## New Outdoor Burning Regulations in Merrill

As of May 8, 2018, The Merrill City Council approved new Outdoor Burning Regulations to better meet the health and cleanliness of Merrill residences.

- 1) Outdoor Burning is allowed from sunrise to sunset. All debris fires are to be extinguished at sunset.
- 2) Only "natural" items can be burned. Limbs, branches, leaves and untreated wood.
- 3) All fires must be attended by a person and have enough water immediately available to extinguish the fire.
- 4) Fires must be burned on the ground and be no bigger than 36 inches in diameter. **NO** burn barrels, wire cages or any other enclosures may be used.
- 5) You **MAY** have small warming fires, barbeques and outdoor fireplaces that burn charcoal and untreated wood. These fires may be burned after sunset.
- 6) Violation of The Merrill Clean Air Burning Regulations 92.01-92.03 can result in fines, not to exceed \$2,000, per offense.
